Gerhard. H.A Visser is professor Emeritus in obstetrics at Utrecht University in the Netherlands. Former chairman in the department of obstetrics, gynecology and neonatology. He is executive Board Member of the European Association of Perinatal Medicine. He is a skilled researcher with more than 800 publications in the field of fetal (neurological) development, fetal monitoring, IUGR, diabetes and pregnancy.



**Ola Andersson MD, PhD, Associate Professor**

Ola Andersson is associated professor in pediatrics at Lund University and a senior consultant in neonatology at Skåne University Hospital in Sweden. His research area is the transition at birth, as the newborn adapts to extrauterine life. He has published several papers on the effect of keeping the umbilical cord intact for more than three minutes, so called delayed cord clamping.
